


## The clinic

## Introduction

Urology specialises in the treatment of diseases of particular organs. These include the adrenal glands, the organs of the urinary tract (kidneys, ureter, bladder, prostate, urethra) and the external male genitals. State-of-the-art technology for extensive and highly specialised diagnostics (e.g. endosonography) and a broad therapeutic range is available to an experienced and committed team of physicians, nursing staff and physiotherapists. With regard to surgery, for example, this ranges from major open surgical interventions to minimally invasive interventions (MIS, DaVinci prostatectomy) which are performed in very high numbers and at a very high quality. The choice of treatment is always determined by the individual clinical and personal history. The newest technology is not sufficient alone. It does not matter whether a severe tumour disease is treated or a reconstruction is performed on a child or infant: human care, friendliness and empathy are an essential part of the therapy at the Urological Clinic. We accompany our patients together with other specialties from the day of admission until surgery and then to the well-prepared discharge.

## ClinicResponsibilities

### The area of responsibility

The area of responsibility of the Urological Clinic includes the diagnosis and treatment of diseases of the efferent urinary passages as well as injuries and malformations of the male genitals. Special emphases is placed on the treatment of tumour diseases, paediatric surgery and plastic-reconstructive urology. Typical examples for the tasks of the Urological Clinic are:

- **Lithiases**  
(renal calculi and uretheroliths, urinary calculi)
- **Prostatism**
- **Surgical therapy of tumour diseases**
- **Chemotherapy, immune therapy and hormone therapy in urological tumour diseases**
- **Hormone substitution therapy in hormone deficit**
- **Plastic-reconstructive urology**
- **Paediatric urology**
- **Prosthetic**
- **Neurourology**
